### The 2016 awards

The **Enviresearch Foundation Travel Award** is intended to add value to existing research of Newcastle University Early Career Researchers (ECRs) working in the area of practical applications of research into the environmentally safe use of chemicals in sustainable agriculture. The types of activities intended to be covered by this award include laboratory, computer modelling or field research within the EEA. The award includes travel, subsistence and accommodation and the possibility of a return visit from the other institution.

The **Enviresearch Foundation Community Award** is intended to support engagement in Science, Environment and Technology through initiatives that help inspire children to learn about science. For example: visits to the LIFE museum, science field trips, inviting scientists into schools. The target age range is school years 6 to 8 (= 10 to 13 year olds).
